Dear Pupils and Parents,

Welcome to Activities Week 2024! This year's activity week is bigger and better than last year and we are excited to share this with you. Activities Week 2024 takes place on Wednesday 17th July through to Tuesday 23rd July. This is taking place during two residential trips that pupils may already be booked onto. These are the year 9 & year 10 trip to Spain and year 7 Camp. This booklet gives you all the information about the activities on offer and their details.

Full payment or a deposit of £10 per activity will need to be made via scopay to secure places on the selected activities. Please select three activities for each day with the 1st being your preferred option. You will only participate in one activity on each day.

There is also the option of choosing the Mystery Activity on some of the days if there are no other activities you would like to do. The mystery activities will be free and will be announced at the beginning of activity week.
