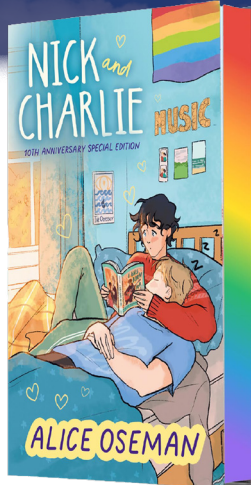


Barnardo's Cooking Sessions
