

## Homework Frequency KS4

All students will have regular HW set across years 9-11. Where possible this will support students to develop independent learning and revision resources as well as consolidate key information.

Each subject will ensure a task is set in-line with the below frequency. Over the course of the year, on average, each subject will set tasks that require at least 45 minutes of student time per school week. Students will be expected to independently revise on top of this in line with their Mayfield exams, Mocks and GCSEs.
