

Music Tuition for KS2 and KS3 2019/20

Dear Parents,

One of our ambitions for our pupils is that they develop their competency as a musician and performer. From September, we are expanding the range of instrumental music tuition that is available to pupils in the Junior and Senior sections.

Our Music lessons will operate as follows:

- Pupils will have a weekly lesson with a fully qualified instrumental music teacher.
- The lessons will last for 30 minutes and will be delivered to groups of 3 during the school day or after school.
- The charge to parents will be £60 per instrument per term, which is equivalent to £5 per week.
- Pupils whose parents who are entitled to free school meals will receive this tuition free of charge.
- The school will hire and provide the instruments for the children to use in school.

To help us to plan the likely demand for these lessons and to enable us to start recruiting music tutors, please can you indicate the instrument(s) that you would like your child to learn from September 2019. At this stage, this is just an expression of interest rather than a firm commitment to start these lessons.
