Re: Forthcoming staffing changes

I am writing to inform you of some forthcoming changes of teaching staff with the Year R Jellyfish and Year 2 Dolphins classes.

As parents of the Jellyfish class will be aware, Miss Hopkinson is pregnant and she is due to start her maternity leave at the start of December. Miss Hopkinson works in the Jellyfish class on Wednesday to Friday and she will be replaced by Mrs Browne, who currently works in the Year 2 Dolphins class on these days.
